La rilevazione campionaria ha consentito, inoltre, di stimare l'impatto degli incentivi all'innovazione sul valore d'impresa; a tal fine, la metrica del valore adottata nell'indagine è l'Economic Value Added (EVATM). A completamento ed arricchimento delle dinamiche colte e commentate sulle politiche di sostegno alla ricerca e innovazione, il volume, nelle conclusioni, suggerisce iniziative di policy idonee a sostenere ed accrescere, in modo virtuoso, la competitività delle PMI.***
